2. Review the brush selection and identify the ones you would like to order.
3. Write down the Series number, size and quantity for each brush.
4. Prepare an email and enter your shopping list.
5. Send email to the Ways & Means Chairperson, Patti Peterson, at pjpatti03@wavecable.com.
Please use "TT Brush Order" in the subject line and identify your phone number, and date needed in the email text body.

THEN:

1. You will receive a confirming email from Patti including any questions on your order, the cost based on your order from the current Scharff price list, and any applicable shipping costs.
2. No money is required until the order is received; we will send you an email when it gets here.
3. Please note that if you require the brush order to be sent to you, it will re-quire your payment if the postage from Port Orchard to the address you designate.

What's New in Decorative Painting!!

This month, designer Deb Antonick of Penticton, BC is bringing her iconic whimsical style to a new venture---SVGs for lasers and CNC routers.

SVG is short for "Scalable Vector Graphics" which is a fancy way of saying this is a program that tells laser cutters and CNC routers how to cut out a design.

Deb has been hard at work converting many of her original designs (including her adorable gnomes!!) into SVGs. Some of the designs have been simplified slightly from the original, but all are suitable for beginning to experienced painters alike.

Deb will be adding new designs frequently as she works her way thru hundreds of designs she and her mentor, Terrye French, created throughout the years, as well as new designs she creates specifically as SVGs. She hopes that her designs will expose a new generation to decorative painting and they will come to love it as much as we do!

The SVGs may be purchased in her new Etsy store, "ATouchofPrimsy". Don't have a laser or CNC?? Have no fear!! Wood blanks can be purchased from her authorized supplier, Chrissie McBride Richardson (new TBT member!) at southsoundmakersmarket.com or at her booth at the Painter's Expo in April (BoyMama Crafts). Canadian supplier will be Southern Ridge Trading. Additional commercial licensees may be added in the future.

A paint list and a color picture of a painted sample are included but no patterns.....use your creativity!! You are limited only by the paint you have....and a quick trip to the craft store takes care of that problem, lol.

Many of the patterns that the SVGs are derived from may be purchased from Deb at paintingwithdeb.com. And join Deb's Facebook group "A Touch of Primsy" for updates on new designs as they become available and other exciting happenings as she brings decorative painting to the laser generation!

Leaves are Hauser Medium Green

Flower is Country Red with Butterscotch center

Bird is Blue Harbor

Nest is Espresso

Egg is Warm White

Sun is Butterscotch
