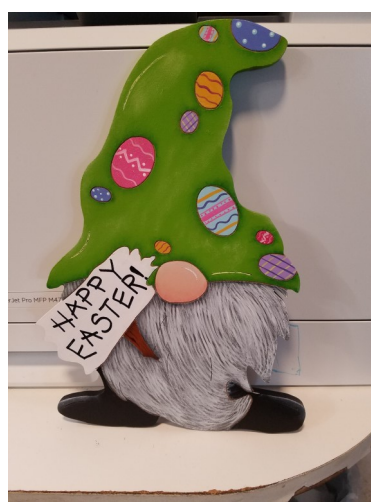
I will be offering some other items as I dig out my craft room so it can be my granddaughters bedroom when she comes for a visit. .
