Scharff Brushes has a website where you can find the price for great brushes to suit any painting project and get 50% off the list price (no special sales apply – but please note that the prices have increased a bit).

Here's the process to get in on this deal:

1. Visit the Scharff Brush site at artbrush.com. *You don't need to open an account because if you order through the club, we have one.*
2. Review the brush selection and identify the ones you would like to order.
3. Write down the Series number, brush name, size and quantity for each brush.
4. Prepare an email and enter your shopping list.
5. Send email to the Ways & Means Chairperson, Patti Peterson, at pjpatti03@wavecable.com. **Please use "TT Brush Order" in the subject line** and identify your phone number, and date needed in the email text body.

NEXT:

1. You will receive a confirming email from Patti including any questions on your order, the cost based on your order from the current Scharff price list, and any applicable shipping costs.
2. No money is required until the order is received; we will send you an email when it gets here. We expect pick-up in person at a meeting, BUT if you require the brush order to be shipped to you, it will require your payment of the postage from Port Orchard to the address you designate.

NOTE: Our total order must be \$300 catalog price to earn the 50 % off brush price. **EVERY ORDER EARNS THE CLUB 20% OF THE BRUSH PRICE!** Freshen up your studio tools and contribute to the club. Have a great time painting!" **Patti P.**

Painting Trivia (*July Answers*):

1. What is Kleister Medium and what is it used for? *This is a Jo Sonja product. "This semi-transparent medium is added to paint to provide extra body for textural patterns for Faux Finishes such as Faux Bois or wood graining techniques.*
2. Name 5 kinds of brushes used in decorative painting and what stroke technique they are used for. *Brushes could include a round, flat, angular, liner, moon, filbert, scrubber, striper, comber or rake, shader, fan, scroller, etc. Check out the Scharff Brush website to see a selection of brushes.*
3. What is "plein air" painting? *"Plein air painting, in its strictest sense, is the practice of painting landscape pictures out-of-doors more loosely; the achievement of an intense impression."*
4. Name 4 painting mediums. *Oil paints, watercolors, acrylic paints, milk paint, metallic paints, paint for plastics, etc. You could also list additives to acrylic paint like flow medium, textile or glazing mediums.*

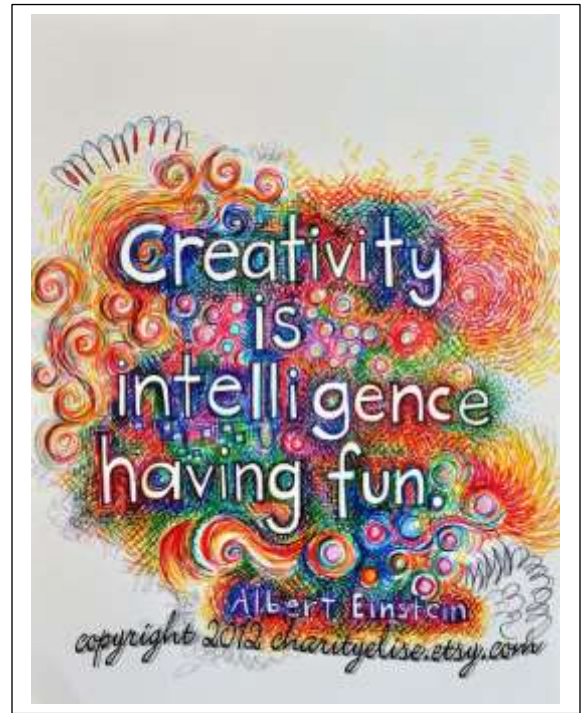
